



Galileo G3 Activity Storybook List


Purpose

Storybooks not only bring joy and excitement to young children they also provide priceless opportunities for learning. Children can develop language and literacy skills, build social and emotional intelligence, learn about problem solving, and much more all through the use of storybooks in the classroom. Reading storybooks aloud can create the foundation for this learning which can be built upon through classroom discussion and activities related to the selected storybook.

Many of the Galileo G3 Activities incorporate storybooks either in a primary role in the activity, as an enrichment opportunity or as a suggested supplement. This document provides a list of storybooks which appear in the Galileo G3 Activities in one of these three roles. To support programs serving English and Spanish speaking children, recommended texts which are available in both English and Spanish, or in a bilingual English/Spanish version are indicated as such.

DESCRIPTION: Children are read the book "Worksong" by Gary and Ruth Paulsen. This rhythmic, rhyming text celebrates the world of work. The text presents a diverse selection of jobs and workers, focusing in particular on an aspect of the work. This activity asks children to identify rhymes, to guess the names of a featured occupation, and to use their reasoning skills to answer comprehension questions.

Suggested Storybooks for Supplementing Activities

There are also many activities within the Galileo G3 Activity Library which recommend that educators select a storybook based on the theme of the activity from their current library but do not call for a specific book to be used. Below is a suggested storybook list to aid in book selection.

DESCRIPTION: In this activity, children are read a book about the general qualities of winter. A list of suggested titles is provided. After the reading, children are asked to help you create a Winter Word Wall of words that have to do with winter. This activity must be completed before the "My Winter Words Book" activity.

MATERIALS:

Large sheet of chart paper or butcher paper

Wide marker

Book about the general qualities of winter (see suggestions in NOTES)

SETUP:

- 1) Bring children to the story area where you have the book.
- 2) Select a story/book that includes many general ideas about winter.

STEPS:

- 1) Introduce the book jacket, title, and author of the selected book. Describe the illustration on the cover of the book.
- 2) As you read the book, encourage children to share their experiences or memories of winter time or vacations. Use the picture clues in the book to make predictions about the next page.
- 3) After finishing the book, ask children to help you create a Winter Word Wall of words that have to do with winter. You may open the book to a page to get them started, or allow them to use examples from their own experiences. As the children begin to share, neatly write each word on the chartpaper. For some words, you can include a simple drawing to show what the word is (i.e., snowman). Try to use single words rather than longer phrases. Some examples of words you want on the chart are: cold, ice, snow, snowball, white, wind, rain, snow, ice, sled, skiing, jacket, mittens, no leaves on trees, ice skating, boots, snow.
- 4) Move this Winter Word Wall to the Writing class area for children to copy for their "My Winter Words Book" activity.

ENRICHMENT:

-With more advanced children, say the word slowly and ask what letter the word starts with as you write the dictated words.

NOTES:

-This activity should occur at the beginning of the week and be followed by the activity titled, "My Winter Words Book."

-Suggested book titles for this activity:

"A Winter Day" by Douglas Florian (a family enjoys a winter day of fun, written in rhyme)

"Winter" by Richard Allington (this is a non-fiction book about winter)

"When Winter Comes" by Nancy Van Laan (rhyming text, asks what happens to different plants and animals when winter comes)

The activity description may describe the use of a storybook in the activity but will not be based on a specific title

The materials list may refer to the use of a storybook based on the activity theme

Suggested storybook titles are listed in the notes section. These are simply suggestions, teachers may use any storybook they have available related to the activity theme
