
# A Guide for Galileo® K-12 Online: Staff Launchpad

### **PURPOSE**

The Galileo Launchpad allows users to customize Galileo to meet their needs and preferences. When logging into Galileo users are automatically brought to their Launchpad, made up of colorful, quick-access navigational tiles. The default set of tiles can be customized with commonly used Galileo interfaces based on the user's role as a teacher or administrator. The Launchpad can be personalized by adding customized categories, tiles for other Galileo interfaces, creating your own tiles with links to external websites, or deleting tiles. Color, icon and order of the navigational tiles can also be customized.

### **ACCESS**

- 1. Log into Galileo.
- 2. The default *Launchpad* displays. (If the *Launchpad* was customized, then the customized version displays.)



3. Or click the **Launchpad** icon accessible from anywhere in the

application to navigate to the *Launchpad* page.



### **NAVIGATE TO A TILE**

- Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)
- 2. Click the desired tile.




3. You will be brought to the desired page.

### **FILTER TILES**

- Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)
- 2. To filter the displayed tiles, click the **All Tiles** menu.
- Click the desired category (e.g., Setup, Assessment, Curriculum, Reports). To view all tiles, click the Show All option.




4. Only the tiles in the selected category displays.



### **MANAGE CATEGORIES**

### **ADD A CATEGORY**

- Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)
- 2. Click the *Manage Tiles* button.
- 3. Select the **Categories** menu.




- 4. Click the *Add New Category* button.
- 5. Type the **Category Title**.
- 6. Click the Save button.
- 7. Click the Close button.
- 8. Click the *Leve Category Mode* button.



#### **EDIT A CATEGORY**

- Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)
- 2. Click the *Manage Tiles* button.

3. Select the **Categories** menu.




- 4. Click the **pencil** icon for the category that should be modified.
- 5. Modify the Category Title.
- 6. Click the Save button.
- 7. Click the Close button.
- 8. Click the *Leve Category Mode* button.



#### **DELETE A CATEGORY**

- Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)
- 2. Click the Manage Tiles button.
- 3. Select the **Categories** menu.



- 4. Click the **trashcan** icon for the category that should be deleted.
- 5. Answer the confirmation message.
- 6. Click the *Leve Category Mode* button.



### **MANAGE TILES**

#### ADD TILES


- Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)
- 2. Click the Manage Tiles button.
- 3. Select the **Add Tiles** menu.



4. Click the **tile(s)** to be added to your customized *Launchpad*.

To create a customized:

- a. Category, refer to the Manage Categories <u>Add a Category</u> section.
- b. tile, refer to the <u>Create Custom</u> Tile section.
- 5. Click the Leave Add Mode button.




6. The selected **tile(s)** displays on the *Launchpad*.


#### **REORDER TILES**

 Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)


- 2. Click the Manage Tiles button.
- 3. Select the **Reorder Tiles** option.



4. Click, hold, and drag the **tile** to its new location.




- 5. Click the Save Changes button.
- 6. Click the *Leave Reorder Mode* button.



7. The **tile(s)** are now rearranged on the *Launchpad*.

#### **REMOVE TILES**

- Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)
- 2. Click the Manage Tiles button.
- Select Edit Tiles menu.



4. Click the **tile(s)** to be removed from your customized *Launchpad*.



User-created tiles are **permanently** removed. ATI-provided tiles can be added back to Launchpad.

- 5. Click the Delete Tile? button.
- 6. Answer the prompt.
- 7. Click the Leave Edit Mode button.




8. The selected **tile(s)** no longer display on the *Launchpad*.

#### **CUSTOMIZE TILE**


Tile customization includes changing the: title, URL, icon, color, and category. The default URL for a Galileo page should not be changed.

- Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)
- 2. Click the *Manage Tiles* button.
- 3. Select Edit Tiles menu.



- 4. Click the **tile** to be customized.
- Make the changes to the tile information (e.g., title, URL, icon, color, and category).

- 6. Click the Save button.
- 7. Click the Close button.
- 8. Click the Leave Edit Mode button.




The selected **tile** has the applied customization.


### **CREATE CUSTOM TILE**

Use this option to create a tile for a frequently accessed page such as the district website, a web resource, and more!


- Access the *Launchpad* page. (Refer to the <u>Access</u> section for directions.)
- 2. Click the Manage Tiles button.
- 3. Select Add Tiles menu.




4. Click Add New Custom Tile.



5. Enter the **tile information** (e.g., title, URL, icon, color, and category).



- 6. Click the Save button.
- 7. Click the Close button.
- 8. Click the Leave Add Mode button.



9. The new **tile** now displays on the *Launchpad*.
